RAISING CONCERNS ABOUT AN ENGINEER

SUBMISSION FORM



As a profession, engineers have set themselves standards. It's our role to make sure they're upheld. If you have concerns about an engineer, use this form to let us know your situation.

FIRST STEPS

There are a few steps you need to work through before you raise a concern with us.

- Check our online Find an engineer tool to see whether the engineer you're concerned about is a Chartered
 Professional Engineer, on another register administered by Engineering New Zealand, or a member of Engineering New
 Zealand.
 - If they're not currently registered or a member and were not at the time of the relevant conduct, Engineering New Zealand has no jurisdiction over them.
 - If they're not currently registered as a Chartered Professional Engineer but they were at the time of the relevant conduct, we can still consider your concerns.
- 2. Consider whether your concerns are something we can help you with. We can help you resolve concerns about:
 - the quality of an engineer's work
 - an engineer's conduct and behaviour.

We can't help you resolve:

- commercial or contractual disputes -we can't compel an engineer to complete work or provide documentation
- x fees and payment disputes
- employment disputes
- concerns about an organisation we can only look at individuals
- we can't help you achieve compensation or reparation.

We can't help you achieve compensation or reparation and we can't order an engineer to undertake specific action in relation to a project.

3. Raise your concerns directly with the engineer first.

This is an important step as many concerns can be resolved effectively through direct communication without the use of the formal concerns process. Raising a concern with Engineering New Zealand is the last resort, not the first. If you have not attempted to resolve the matter with the engineer directly first, we may refuse to accept your concern.

WHAT'S NEXT?

If you have tried but have been unable to resolve your concerns directly with the engineer, your next step is to get in touch with us to discuss your concerns. If you need help completing this form, or if you have any questions about how we use your information, give us a call on 04 460 3571.

Before filing your concern with us, please ensure you have all the evidence available (e.g. engineering reports that help prove your concern). We may refuse or close a concern that is based on evidence you have yet to obtain. There is no specific time limit on raising a concern, so take the time to obtain all evidence before officially lodging your concern.

Once we've assessed your concern, we'll talk with the engineer and ask for a response. For this reason, it is important that you feel comfortable with your concern being shared with the engineer at the time you raise your concern with us. If you do not want to share your concern with the engineer but still file this concern form, your concern will be dismissed.

If you are unsure about whether you would like to raise a formal concern at this stage, we encourage you to speak with us so we can give you an overview of the complaints process and what raising a concern means for you.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Our concerns and complaints process is confidential to the parties involved. Engineering New Zealand will only share information relating to the complaint in accordance with our Rules and Disciplinary Regulations, and applicable legislation. Parties to the concerns and complaints process must agree to comply with our reasonable directions about confidentiality and name suppression.
