

OUTSTANDING EMERGING PROFESSIONAL AWARD RECOGNISING AN OUTSTANDING ENGINEER

OBJECTIVES OF THE AWARD

Awarded to a engineer who has demonstrated outstanding leadership qualities, excellence in their career and a contribution to their community. They must be able to communicate how their work makes New Zealanders' lives better.

CRITERIA

Nominees for this award should:

- 1. Be at the start of their journey as an engineer. There is no age restriction for this award!
- 2. Display admirable qualities
- 3. Inspire others and show extraordinary enthusiasm to contribute to engineering
- 4. Show extraordinary potential to be a leader of tomorrow.

NATURE OF THE AWARD

- a) Outstanding Emerging Professional Award: Only one Outstanding Emerging Professional Award may be made in each year. The Judges have the discretion not to give an Outstanding Emerging Professional Award if none of the entries are considered of a sufficient standard.
- b) The Awards in each category shall consist of a certificate, an inscribed plaque and a copy of the Judges' citation.

- c) All finalists will receive a certificate acknowledging their achievement.
- d) The entrants accept that the Judges' decisions are final and that no correspondence will be entered into.

ELIGIBILITY

- a) Nominees must be located within Auckland, New Zealand.
- The Award entry needs to be supported by a current Member of Engineering New Zealand's Auckland Branch.
